COMMON QUESTION - DO WE NEED TO TAKE THE CLASSES OVER?

- NO. THERE IS NO FEMA REQUIREMENT TO RE-TAKE THE NEW COURSES. HOWEVER, EACH AGENCY
- **FEMA recommends that people take the newer versions of courses to remain current with the latest developments in NIMS. This is to help ensure they maintain knowledge and skills, especially personnel who are not regularly involved in complex multi-jurisdictional incidents.**
- **FEMA recommends that all instructors retake all prerequisite and primary courses they are authorized to instruct by the Authorities Having Jurisdiction (AHJ).**

 - REQUIRED - REVIEW NIMS 2017 LEARNING MATERIALS
 - REQUIRED - PARTICIPATE IN COURSE ROLLOUT WEBINARS
 - REQUIRED - PASS END OF COURSE TEST – 80% - CLOSED BOOK
- INSTRUCTORS LIST – ALL INSTRUCTORS WILL BE IDENTIFIED AS REQUIRING UPDATE IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN A CURRENT LIST
 - STOs (AND STATEWIDE INTEROPERABILITY COORDINATOR (SWIC) FOR COML) WILL VERIFY THREE TASKS COMPLETE
 - CAN ADD ADDITIONAL STEPS (TEACH BACKS, INSTRUCTOR QA/QC, ETC.)
 - MUST NOTIFY EMI AHPS TS/CM VIA EMAIL, BY NAME
 - INSTRUCTORS LIST – WILL BE ANNOTATED WITH UPDATED INSTRUCTORS
- POST RELEASE +3 MONTHS NEW COURSE – NON-CURRENT INSTRUCTORS WILL BE REMOVED
- FUTURE INSTRUCTOR ADDS – AFTER TtT + RECOMMENDATION OF STO (AND SWIC FOR COML)

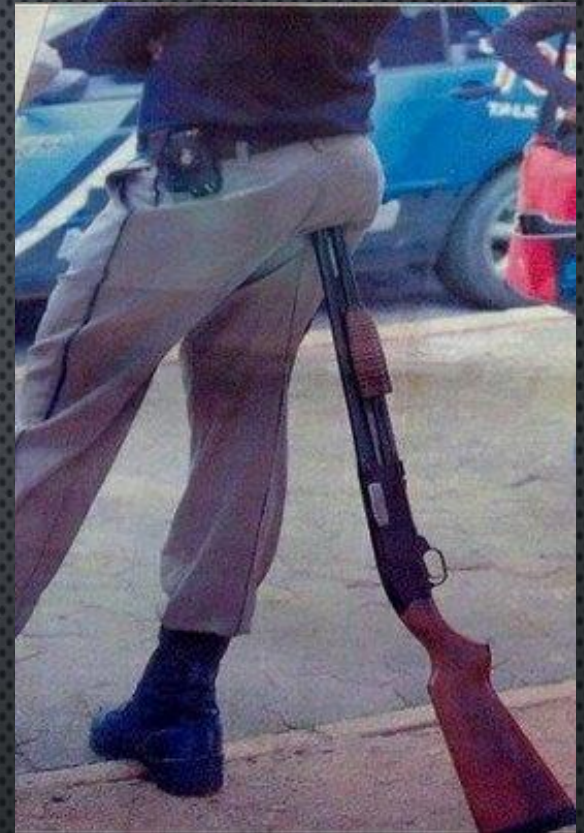

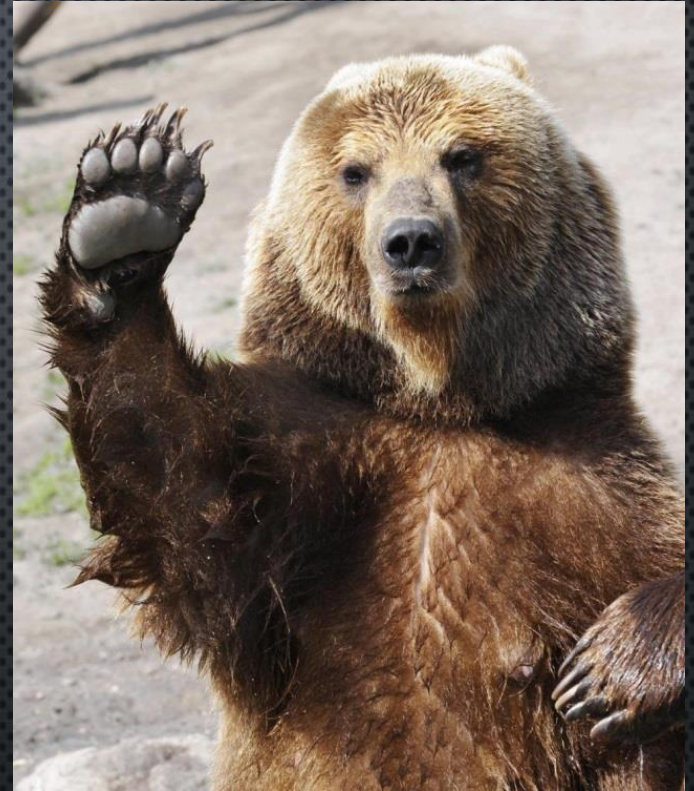
